

Priddy Parish Council - Annual report

Priddy Village Hall

Covid 19 has meant this past year has been a bit of a non-event for Priddy Village Hall.

However, we have taken the opportunity to quite extensively refurbish the hall.

The old Chair Store has been repurposed as a small meeting room, newly painted and carpeted with a window being put into the external door. This external door could be used as a possible entry point for a small group (4 – 6) wishing to use the room only for a meeting whilst the main hall is in use, or a person wishing to use it as a Hot Desk (Office Space facility) with a laptop and access to our hall WiFi system. The area containing the hot water storage off from the meeting room now has a secure door added.

The room behind the stage has now been modified and has become the new chair and table store, so again newly painted and with a purpose-built table rack built in along the wall holding the 20 tables for hall hirers usage. This removes the need now for dragging the tables out from under the stage which was always hard work with the trolleys for ever needing maintenance.

The space and trolleys under the stage can now be re-utilised.

The tired looking hall floor has been professionally sanded and varnished providing hopefully a hard-wearing surface for years to come. The main hall again has been repainted and freshened up. The Priddy Shield now has a clear acrylic cover to protect it from future damage and abuse.

It is our intention to hold a viewing opportunity, socially distanced of course, on the evening of Monday 17th May, 1630hrs to 1900hrs and all are very warmly invited to come and have a look at what is 'your' village hall.
